The Ohio Statehouse was completed in 1861 at the beginning of America's Civil War. Restored to its 1861 appearance, the Statehouse maintains its historic character as it continues to function as the center of state government in Ohio.

The Ohio Statehouse represents one of America's finest examples of Greek Revival architecture and is one of the oldest working statehouses in the United States. Guests can learn more about Ohio through guided tours, educational displays, special programming and the **Ohio** Statehouse Museum Education Center. The Statehouse Museum Shop offers Ohiothemed gifts and the Capitol Cafe offers breakfast and lunch weekdays.
